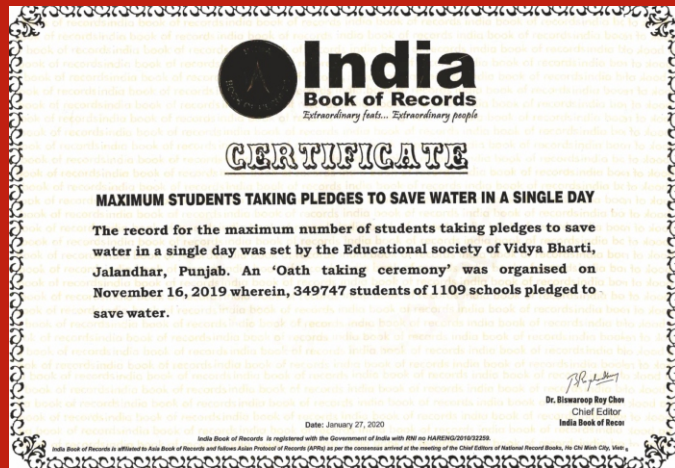

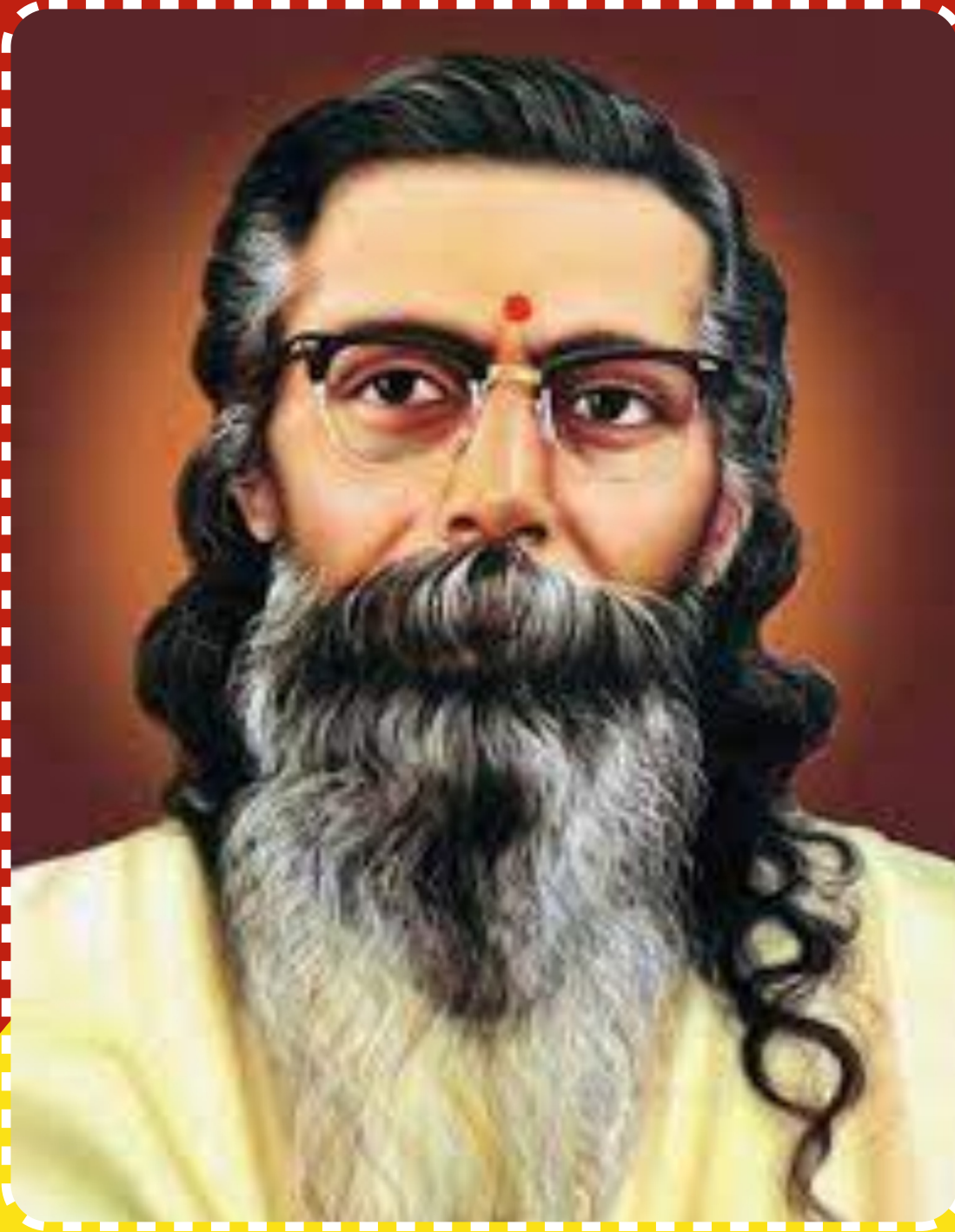

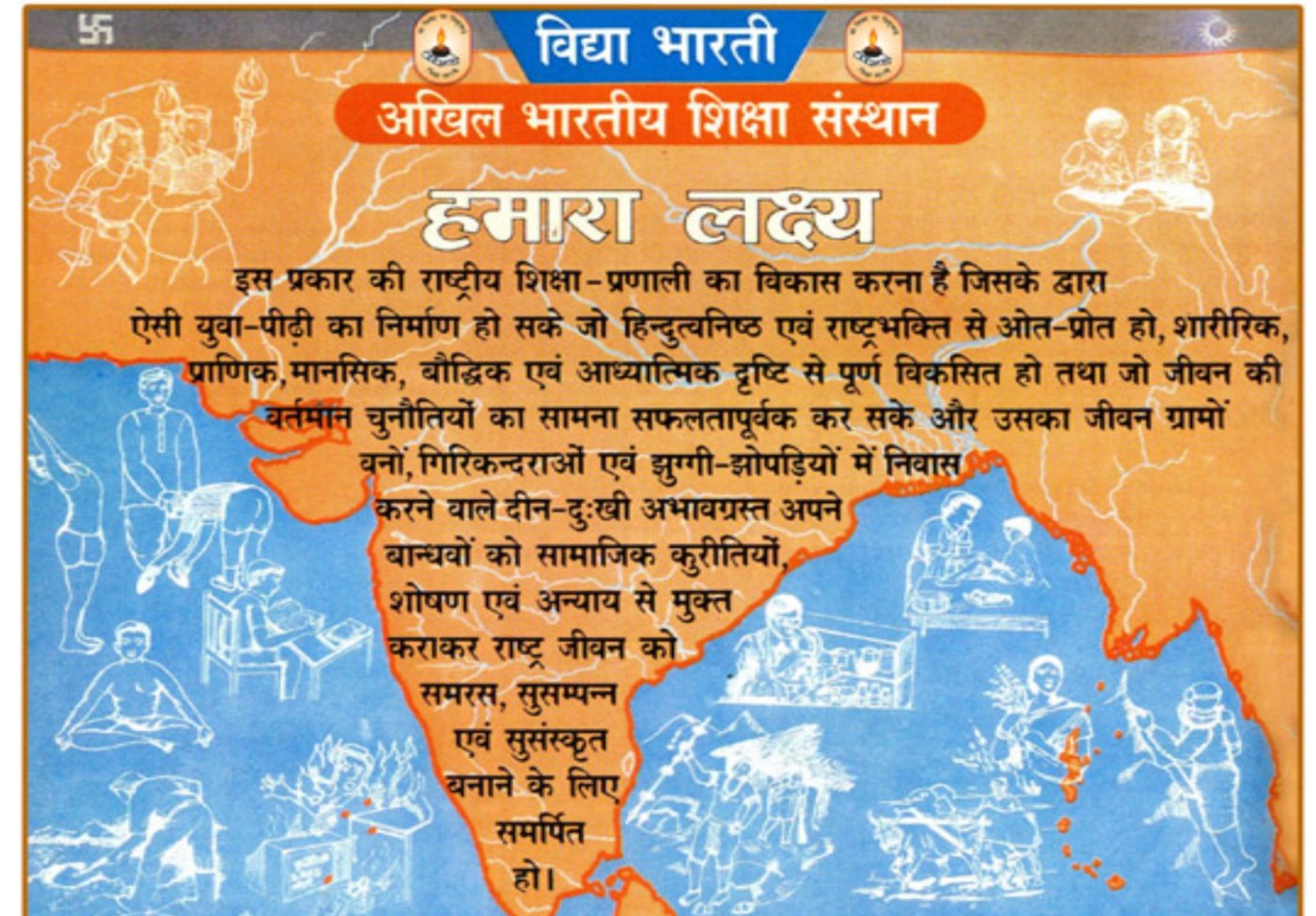

## ABOUT

### VIDYA BHARATI

### AKHIL BHARATIYA SHIKSHA SANSTHAN

Some committed and patriotic people, who considered education as an artifice to educate the young generation according to Indian values and culture started the first school in Gorakhpur, UP, in 1952. They named this school as Saraswati Shishu Mandir-Temple of the Goddess Saraswati dedicated to the children. Thanks to their zeal, dedication and hard work that similar schools began to be established at other places also. The number of such schools increased rapidly in Uttar Pradesh. A state-level Shishu Shiksha Prabandh Samiti was formed in 1958 for their proper guidance and planned development. Good education & sound sanskars at the Saraswati Shishu Mandirs earned recognition, honor, and popularity in the society. Shishu Mandirs started spreading in other states and within a few years, many schools were established. To manage the affairs in different regions, state-level committees were set-up. The formation of a national body came in 1977 and Vidya Bharati Akhil Bharatiya Shiksha Sansthan was established with its Registered office at Lucknow & functional headquarters in Delhi. All state-level committees were affiliated to this Vidya Bharati Akhil Bharatiya Shiksha Sansthan.





## Brief Profile

## Pursuit of Excellence

**Genius Examination** - Sarvhitkari Educational Society (Regd.) has been organising "Genius Competitive Examination" since 2016 in order to develop competitive spirit among the students. The Students of class 8<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> appear for the examination. Toppers are given cash prizes amounting to Rupees 1 lakh.

**Sarvhitkari Super 100** - It is true that a strong foundation is needed to erect a huge and grand edifice. In order to strengthen the foundation of students, Sarvhitkari Education Society has started a pre-foundation course named "Super 100" for meritorious students of classes 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>. It is being run through online mode under the guidance of Scientists from ISRO / DRDO. Around 119 students are taking the benefit of these classes.

**Foreign Language Course** - In order to develop the inter - personal communication skills, different types of trainings are organised by SES. Simultaneously, the society has organized classes of German, French, Chinese Language Course in which many teachers of different French/Chinese schools successfully participated and were awarded certificates. More courses are in the pipe line.

**Sanskriti Bodh Pariyojna** - Different types of programs are organised from time to time by Vidya Bharati at all India level under the aegis of Sanskriti Bodh project, so that our students, teachers and parents get information about our rich Indian culture and values. Special programs like Quiz, essay writing competitions of teachers and students are organized. Apart from these, a special test named Sanskriti Gyan exam is also conducted. During the last three years the society made special efforts to reach out to other schools. These efforts bore fruit and apart from Sarvhitkari schools, about 500 other schools also participated in this examination.

**Skill Development** - It is a process of identifying skill gap and ensuring students to develop skills. Sarvhitkari Educational Society (Regd.) has decided to introduce skills, namely Artificial Intelligence, Beauty & Wellness, Handcraft etc. for students of classes 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> during session 2022-23 and vocational courses for 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> students as per guidelines of the respective education board.

**NEP 2020** - Provisions of national education policy 2020 will be implemented as per government guidelines. School Staff member are fully enlightened and trained under NEP 2020 and they are prepared at all levels for effective implementation under the principles of multilingualism, multidisciplinary of education, flexibility in choice of subjects for students, conceptual and experiential learning etc.

## ADMISSIONS:

**AGE CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION:** Child will have to meet the stipulated age requirement for admission to the School as on March 1st of that year. The required age limit for each grade is mentioned below. The stipulated age limit may be relaxed at the discretion of the School Admission Committee based on past academic achievements and performance in our testing procedures, provided the student has been from a recognized school.

**MVN offers admissions from Preschool to Std. IX & XI subject to the availability of seats and eligibility**

Admission to the school is through an interaction and the admission test. The Admission Test will be conducted at School campus and parents will be intimated about the date and time. Every child seeking admission must be introduced to the Principal by the parents/guardian.



## DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

- Original Birth Certificate from the Competent Authority
- Self-Attested copy of student's Aadhaar Card.
- Original School Leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate from the previous school duly signed by the Head of the Institution.
- Original Report Card of the last class from the previous school.
- Out station students must submit documents duly counter signed by the competent authority.
- Proof of Residential Address.
- Original Migration Certificate in case child comes from another Board.
- SC/ST/BC candidates are to submit relative certificate from the Competent Authorities.

**Note : No Admission will be deemed to be complete and valid till the above mentioned documents are submitted.**

### ADMISSION / CONCESSION POLICY 2023-24

The school provides for concessions in fee / charges as per laid down policy to the students.

#### a) Sibling Concession

25% concession in tuition fee is granted to the sibling.

#### b) Single Girl Child Concession

25% concession in tuition fee is granted to girl student who is the only child in the family.

#### c) Mother Headed Family Concession

25% concession in tuition fee is granted to the student who is unfortunately deprived of the care of his father.

#### d) Economically Weaker Section Concession

25% concession in tuition fee is granted to the student whose family income from all sources is less than Rs. 10,000/-. Per month certificate duly signed by an appropriate authority is required.

#### e) Meritorious Student Concession

- i) 50% concession in tuition fee to meritorious students who score more than 90% marks in board exams.
- ii) 25% concession in tuition fee to those who score more than 80% marks.

#### f) Sports/Co-curricular Concession

- i) 50% concession in tuition fee to the students who

hold National level position in any sport /co-curricular activity.

- ii) 25% concession in tuition fee to those who hold State level position.

#### g) Scholarship Based Concession

50% concession in tuition fee /Annual charges to the student who tops in the respective grade/class in the Scholarship Examination held by the school.

#### h) Category Based Concession

25% concession in tuition fee /Annual charges to students belonging to SC/ST category.

#### i) Others

- i) 50% concession in tuition fee /Annual charges to the wards of Defense / Para. Military personals.
- ii) 100% concession to the wards of those who died in security operations.
- iii) 50% concession in tuition fee /Annual charges to Divyang students.

**Note:-** 1. The benefits/concessions can be withdrawn in case any incorrect information is provided by the parents or involvement of the child in any case of indiscipline.  
2. The concessions will be reviewed periodically and should not be treated as a permanent feature.
